2. COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION FORUM-5 MINUTE LIMITATION.

In accordance with State law, no action shall be taken on any item presented in public forum or unscheduled matters unless the council, by majority vote, determines that an EMERGENCY situation exists, or, unless the council by two-thirds vote, finds that the need to take action arose after this agenda was posted.

3. Purchasing Authority related to repair of the 2nd Street Fresh Water Pump Facility:

Council is asked to consider granting purchasing authority to the City Administrator related to repair of the 2nd Street fresh water pumping facility. A failure of the vertical turbine pump caused additional electrical failures. Due to the critical nature of the pump for both domestic water supply and fire suppression water supply we propose to begin that work on Thursday on an emergency basis. It would appear that the work needs to be accomplished, has few (if any) viable alternatives, is of a critical nature to the City of Biggs, and is unlikely to yield a significant price variance in a bid process, and therefore qualifies for consideration of an emergency purchase authority.

Recommendation: Suspend bidding requirements and authorize the City Administrator to purchase goods and services related to the repair of the 2nd Street Fresh Water Pump Facility.
