TO: Honorable Mayor and Members of the City Council

FROM: City Administrator

SUBJECT: Authorize purchase of services - Road Trench Repair and Repave

Council is being asked to consider proposals to repair and repave (4) road trenches.

Recommendation:

Authorize the City Administrator to contract with Duke Sherwood Contracting for the repair and repave of (4) road trenches in the amount of \$7,571.00.

Fiscal Impact:

\$7,571.00

Background:

A recent water line breach in the middle of E Street (between 6th and 7th Streets) caused significant damage to the road surface, and the subsequent water line repair necessitated a trench across the width of E Street. The area currently has a temporary patch. Due to the significant pavement area involved (approx. 193 square feet), being on a truck route, and the lack of asphalt finishing equipment within public works it is advisable to enlist the services of a properly equipped contractor to repair and repave the trench.

Because we pay to mobilize the contractor's resources to the site, it tends to be less expensive per square foot to repave incrementally larger areas. In an effort to get the most for our money we decided to consider including (3) other old road trenches that had settled. (2) are in the same block of E Street, and the last trench extends most of the distance across B Street (in front of the credit union).

The repair and repave project would repair and repave all (4) of the trenches.

We propose to furnish all materials, equipment, labor and supervision as necessary to complete the following work:

1. Saw cut failed asphalt area, remove existing temporary paving and replace with ½" asphalt concrete to match existing section, to a maximum depth of 4" on approximately 235 SF. (E St.)
2. Saw cut failed asphalt area, remove existing asphalt concrete, place back w/½" asphalt concrete to match existing section, to a maximum depth of 4" on approximately 96 SF. (B. St.)
3. Saw cut failed asphalt area, remove existing asphalt concrete, place back w/½" asphalt concrete to match existing section, to a maximum depth of 4" on approximately 82 SF. (E. St.)
4. Saw cut failed asphalt area, remove existing asphalt concrete, place back w/½" asphalt concrete to match existing section, to a maximum depth of 4" on approximately 176 SF. (E. St.)

All materials are guaranteed to be as specified and completed in a workman like manner for the sum of **SEVEN THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY DOLLARS (\$7,760.00)**

WITH PAYMENT MADE AS FOLLOWS: 100% UPON COMPLETION WITHOUT RETENTION.



Contractor proposes to furnish and install all labor, material and equipment necessary to complete the following work at the subject sites per the item description summaries contained below and tjob site visit on 10/30/2012:

Summaries and Stipulations:

Street Repair: Sawcut and remove various square footages at 4 different locations of damaged asphalt city street. Place 3/4" asphalt concrete to a finished thickness of 4" over areas. Traffic control included for scope of work. Work on E street assumes closure to through traffic. Prevailing wages apply.

EXCLUSIONS

Permits, fees, engineering, and compaction testing.
Erosion control installation, permits, fees, and plan.
Additional insurance above \$5,000,000 liability.
Removal of unsuitable soil, and work during inclement weather.
Handling and removal of hazardous materials.
Cost of bonds. Bond rate available upon request.
Signage, striping, pavement markers.
Slurry seal, primecoat or fogseal.
Message Boards or prior notification.
Anything not specifically included in scope description.

CONDITIONS

This proposal is based on one move in. No weekend work included, except for our convenience.

Price Escalation for Asphalt Concrete: Upon acceptance of this quote owner acknowledges that the price of raw materials (i.e. fuel, liquid asphalt, et.) may increase during the term of this contract. In the event that contractor incurs cost increase(s) in raw materials in excess of 5% for the material quoted then owner and contractor shall negotiate to mutually agree upon a revised price for the material yet to be delivered under this proposal (\$85.00/Ton). If the parties cannot agree upon a revised price for such material, then either party may, upon two (2) days written notice, terminate this agreement with respect to any material not yet delivered to owner as of the date of termination.

All material is guaranteed to be as specified. All work to be completed in a professional manner according to standard practices. Any alteration or deviation from above specifications involving extra costs will be executed only upon written orders, and will become an extra charge over and above the estimate. All agreements are contingent upon strikes, accidents or delays beyond our control. Our workers are fully covered by Worker's Compensation Insurance.
