## Agenda Item Staff Report For the Regular City Council Meeting: January 14, 2014

TO: Honorable Mayor and Members of the City Council  
FROM: City Administrator  
SUBJECT: Authorization to Replace Two Light Trucks.

Council is asked to consider authorizing the sale of two trucks, to purchase two replacement light trucks, and to increase the expense budget of Fund 011 by \$10,000.

### Background

The city currently owns the following light trucks which are primarily used for public works activities, and one for code enforcement activities.

Staff requests authorization to sell the following two trucks:

1998	Ford	F150	1FTZF172XWNA01082	150,279
2002	Ford	Ranger	1FTYR10D02TA41943	77,358

We currently have a quote of \$8,343.09 to repair the 1998 F150, and a quote of \$4,667.41 to repair a 2002 Ranger. Neither vehicle is worth the cost of repair. And another Ford Ranger is currently in the repair shop.

The proceeds of the sale would be credited to Fund 011 Building and Equipment Reserve.

Simultaneously, staff proposes to solicit bids for (2) ½ ton trucks. Total per unit cost is expected to be in the area of \$19,000-\$23000.

### Fiscal Impact:

The current budget includes a \$40,000 allocation from Fund 011. As of Nov 2013 Fund 011 had a balance of \$115,000.

**Recommendation:**

Authorize the City Administrator to sell the following vehicles:
