Since 2006 a subsidiary of Waste Management has provided solid waste disposal services to the City of Biggs. The current contract as amended expires on January 31, 2016.

Therefore the recommendation is to authorize staff to issue and RFP and provide direction regarding the desired process for RFP evaluation and service contract negotiations.

Dear Prospective Applicant,

The City of Biggs will be considering applications for city wide, residential solid waste removal.

Collection of commercial/industrial refuse should not be included in your proposal. Non-residential collection will be a separate contract between the customer and vendor.

An exclusivity clause in the contract is acceptable.

The city will bill and collect fees for service from residential customers served.

As part of proposal, provide requirements for periodic rate increases.

Three bin per household

- 35 gal. household trash;
- 64 gal. recycling;
- 96 gal. yard waste.

Weekly pick-up of all three bins, on the same day

Twice yearly City-Wide Clean-Up Day with collection of hazardous items such as batteries, oil and paint. Please provide a price per event.

Optional bin upgrade directly through collector – upgrade cost billed directly by collector
