Subject: SB1 - Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA)

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**Regarding: SB1 Project List for FY 18-19 to the California Transportation Commission (CTC)**

## **Background**

On April 28, 2017, the Governor signed Senate Bill (SB) 1 (Beall, Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017), which is known as the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017. To address basic road maintenance, rehabilitation and critical safety needs on both the state highway and local streets and road system, SB 1: increases per gallon fuel excise taxes; increases diesel fuel sales taxes and vehicle registration fees; and provides for inflationary adjustments to tax rates in future years. Beginning November 1, 2017, the State Controller (Controller) will deposit various portions of this new funding into the newly created Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA). A percentage of this new RMRA funding will be apportioned by formula to eligible cities and counties pursuant to Streets and Highways Code (SHC) Section 2032(h) for basic road maintenance, rehabilitation, and critical safety projects on the local streets and roads system. SB 1 emphasizes the importance of accountability and transparency in the delivery of California's transportation programs. Therefore, to be eligible for RMRA funding, statute requires cities and counties to provide basic annual RMRA project reporting to the California Transportation Commission (Commission).

### Project List Flexibility:

Pursuant to SHC Section 2034(a)(1), this project list shall not limit the flexibility of an eligible city or county to fund projects in accordance with local needs and priorities, so long as the projects are consistent with SHC Section 2030(b). After submittal of the project list to the Commission, in the event a city or county elects to make changes to the project list pursuant to the statutory provision noted above, formal notification of the Commission is not required. However, the Project Expenditure Report form that is due to the Commission by October 1st

each year, will provide an opportunity for jurisdictions to annually communicate such changes to the Commission as part of the regular reporting process.

**The City's Street Project List for FY 2018/19 is due to CTC by May 1, 2018.**

**Budget**

The State has created the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) where new SB1 funds will be deposited for distribution to the City. The projected revenue for the City of Biggs for FY 2018/19 is \$86,018.

**Recommendation**

Staff respectfully requests that the City Council adopt a resolution authorizing the City Staff to submit the SB1 Project List to CTC, and the City Administrator to include in Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Budget CIP the projects to be funded with SB1 - Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BIGGS  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR  
TO INCORPORATE IN THE 2018-19 BUDGET A LIST OF PROJECTS FUNDED BY  
SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT**

**WHEREAS**, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 in order to address the significant transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

**WHEREAS**, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the public is aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS**, the City must include a list of all street and road projects proposed to receive funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, in the City budget, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

**WHEREAS**, the SB 1 project list can be revised by the City at any time to address changing priorities in our street and road maintenance and safety needs.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

The City of Biggs authorizes the City Administrator to incorporate in the 2018-19 Budget a list of projects funded by SB1 – The Road Repair and Accountability Act.
