Phase 2 WWTP Improvement Project

Funding SRF:

The approved funding amount is \$9,624,569 which includes \$6,000,000 in grant.

Permitting:

The Regional Board has not responded to our request to extend the TSO to November 1, 2018. We are beginning to prepare a Report of Waste Discharge, which is required for the City's WDR (Waste Discharge Requirements) Permit needed for land application of the treated effluent.

Expenditures:

Design and Construction:

Final design work for construction now moving forward. The anticipated schedule is:

100% PS&E to City for Review – October 2018
Bid project – December 2018
Award Construction Contract – February 2019
Construction Start – May 2019

Tank and Pump Station Project

Michael Baker is preparing the draft IS/MND. Amendment for Phase II and Geotech Report is enclosed. The anticipated schedule for this project is as follows:

- Draft IS/MND – May 2018
- Final IS/MND – June 2018
- Phase II Soil Assessment Completed –July 2018
- Funding Application Submittal – July 2018
- Design Start – June 2018
- Bid Project for Construction – Dec 2018
- Construction Start – April 2019

Biggs Park Improvements Project

Construction is well underway and all work is planned to be completed before June 30 to meet the grant program deadline. The City has requested all the available State grant funds in the amount of \$406,100. After June 30, City staff will prepare a final report of expenditure for submittal to State.

State Park Grant Funds:

F Street Water Main Replacement

The City received bids from three contractors and City staff is recommending awarded of the contract for City Council consideration. Bid results are as follows:

ATP (Cycle 2) SRTS Project – B Street & Second Street (north)

Plans were completed in April and the project went out to bid. Bids were received on May 2 and Bennett will review to provide a recommendation to City regarding the contract award (see separate Agenda Item). Coordination continues with UPRR and CPUC for improvements to B Street sidewalk crossing at railroad.

CMAQ/ATP (Cycle 4) SRTS along E Street

Bennett has release the Request for Proposal (RFP) for design of the ATP Cycle 4 SRTS along E Street project. Proposals are due on June 13, 2018. Once the proposals are reviewed for completeness, a City selection panel will evaluate the proposals and make a recommend to City Council for award of the design services contract.

2018 Pavement Repair Project

City Council previous approved a task order for Bennett to prepare the project plans and specifications for a city street pavement repair project with a construction target amount of \$200,000. The plan & specs were completed in April and the project was posted for construction bids. Bids will be received on May 8 and Bennett will review the bids and provide a recommendation to City regarding the contract award. See separate Agenda Item.

Public Works Equipment Purchase - Information

The Public Works Department is in need of a utility tractor with mower and front loader. PWD currently has a backhoe tractor with front loader, but the backhoe is limited in function due to its lack of mobility and versatility. The backhoe is good for excavation and for working in one location, but is not effective or useful for other needs such as mowing, ditch grading, disking, spreading of material, and road pavement repair work. City staff has collected equipment specifications and price quotes for the recommended equipment. See attached equipment photos.
