Subject: ATP Cycle 2 – Safe Routes to School Project

Regarding:

Construction Contract Award for ATP Cycle 2 – Safe Routes to School Project #18-03

Background:

The City of Biggs has received ATP state grant funds for construction of this project in the amounts of \$599,000. Two construction bids were received on May 2 with the following bid results:

Franklin Construction Inc.:	\$950,975 (apparent low bidder)
All-American Construction Inc.:	\$1,303,909

City staff recommends award of the contract to the low bidder, Franklin Construction, for the Base Bid plus the Additive Alternative Bid #1 and Bid #2 (north and south UPRR crossings) for a total contract amount of \$772,975. The Additive Alternative Bid #3 for the Street Lighting is not recommended due to the high bid cost.

	Low Bid
Base Bid:	\$704,139
Add Alt#1(north UPRR):	\$ 39,425
Add Alt#2(south UPRR):	\$ 29,411

Total: \$772,975

City staff will work with the contractor to identify work scope and items that can be reduced or eliminated from the project to reduce the overall construction expenditure to be more in line with the amount of State ATP funds allocated and, thereby reduce the amount of City general funds needed.

Budget:

ATP State funds in the amount of \$599,000 for construction.

Additional City General funds for construction are estimated in the amount between \$100,000 and \$173,975.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends: City Council authorize the City Administrator to execute a construction contract with Franklin Construction, Inc. for the ATP Cycle 2 Safe Routes to Schools project in the amount of \$772,975.
