

**1. SPECIAL MEETING CALLED TO ORDER:**

The Special Meeting of the Biggs City Council was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Mayor Frith. Vice Mayor Thompson, Councilmembers Bottorff and Sheppard were present. Councilmember Arnold was absent. Staff present: City Administrator Mark Sorensen, City Engineer Steve Speights and City Clerk Roben Dewsnup.

**2. STREET REPAIR PRIORITIES:**

City Engineer Steve Speights stated there were about 11 miles of paved streets in the City of Biggs which included local, arterial and collector streets. In 2005, the city had a pavement management report completed and at that time, 70 percent of the streets were rated poor or very poor. At that time the cost to bring the streets to an optimal condition was 10 million dollars. The city currently has \$220,000 saved to repair streets.

Mr. Speights presented the following options:


- Repair streets in good condition before they get worse
- Repair very poor residential streets
- Repair streets with heavy truck volume
- Improve local minor streets in poor condition
- Purchase equipment for public works to make repairs

Mayor Frith asked for suggestions from the public.

Mr. Speights would compile the information he received and bring back to council.
